ALUMINUM	699,088 LBS	You saved enough energy to run a TV for 40,547,104 hours!
PLASTICS	1,661,170 LBS	You saved 87,286 gallons of gasoline!
ELECTRONICS	1,201,929 LBS	You saved enough energy to power 33,791 homes for 1 day!
GLASS	9,786,795 LBS	You saved about 58,591 trash bags from ending up in a landfill!
SCRAP METAL	21,436,038 LBS	You saved 31,939,697 pounds of iron ore!
PAPER &/OR CARDBOARD	22,451,788 LBS	You saved 190,840 trees!

AVOIDED EMISSIONS



Recycling uses much less energy than making products from virgin resources, and using less energy means fewer greenhouse gases emitted into the atmosphere.

By recycling the materials above, you avoided about **201,676,470** lbs. of carbon dioxide emissions. This is equivalent to removing **20,399** passenger cars from the road for an entire year!
